**Anarchy**

Absence of government or law and order, Anomie

**Allegory**

A story, poem, or picture that reveals a hidden political or moral meaning

Protection, backing, or support of a powerful person or institution.

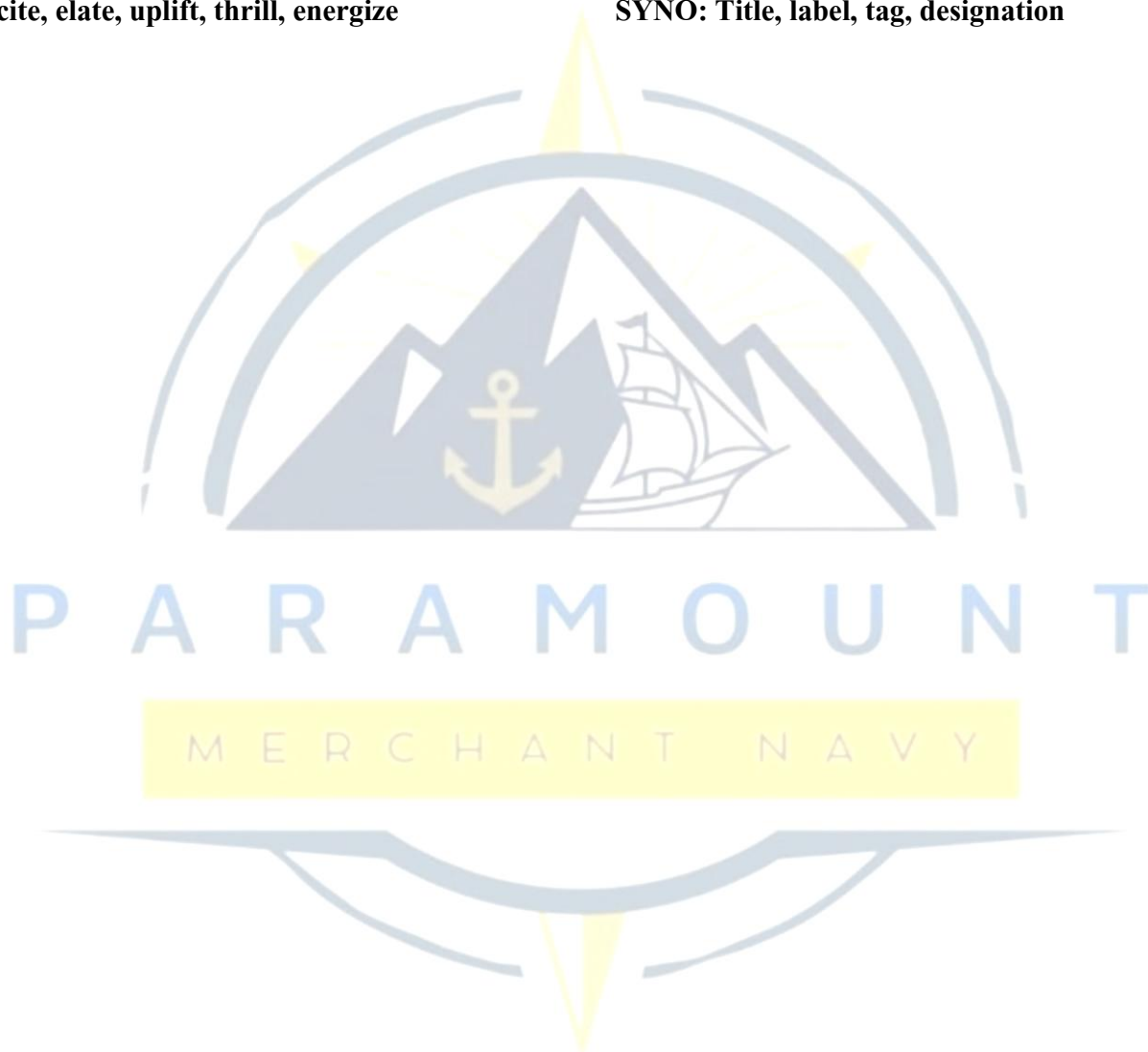
